

ODP Offers Training on Online Provider Profiles

AUDIENCE:

Administrative Entities (AEs), Supports Coordination Organization (SCO) Leadership

PURPOSE:

This Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) Announcement communicates the availability of training on ODP's Online Provider Profiles for AEs and SCO Leadership.

DISCUSSION:

ODP launched Online Provider Profiles as a key effort to continuously improve quality and choice for individuals and families on July 1, 2019. Provider Profiles consist of two parts: 1. a Provider Summary developed and submitted by the Provider; 2. a Provider Data Display showing the Provider's performance in supporting individuals and families.

This is Phase 1 of ODP's Provider Profiles project. In this phase, Provider Summaries and Data Displays are available on MyODP.org for 84 residential providers with 10 or more individual surveys in the 2017 Independent Monitoring for Quality (IM4Q) Data File. IM4Q Scale Scores are displayed for each Provider in areas including Individual Satisfaction, Choice, Inclusion, Dignity, Family Satisfaction, and Physical Setting.

ODP's Provider Profiles web page also connects viewers with additional information about Providers, including licensing information and Quality Assessment and Improvement (QA&I) Comprehensive Reports. Using this web page, individuals and families can easily reach the Services and Supports Directory (SSD) to search for a service provider, and COMPASS, where they can register for services. ODP's Provider Profiles web page also offers a meaningful list of Recommended Questions for Individuals and Families to ask Providers of interest when visiting them.
