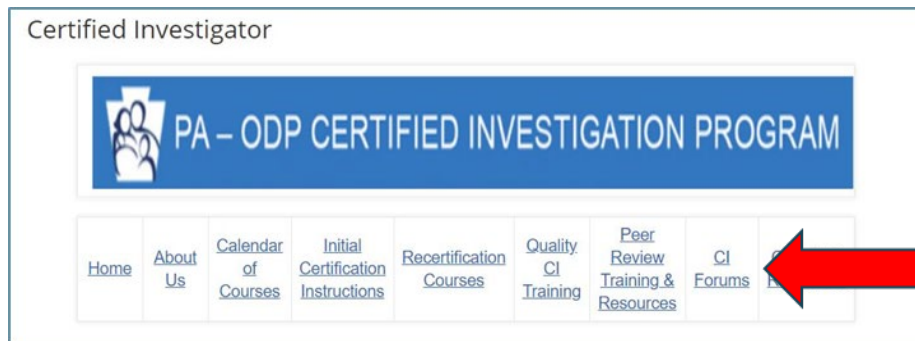

How do you register for the CI Forum? Registration will be open until COB Wednesday November 6th:

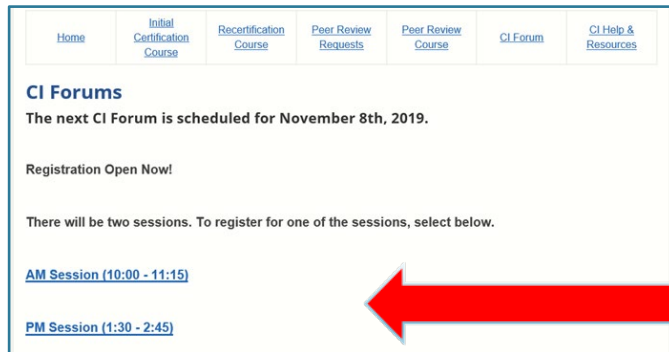
1. Navigate to <https://www.myodp.org/>
