January 3 2pm – 3pm	VOH	Open Dialogue on Technology for People with Disabilities	All professionals in the field	This will be an opportunity to continue the conversation begun at ODP's October 2019 technology conferences about the role of assistive technology in increasing the independence of people with disabilities. Participants will learn about new ODP initiatives and how assistive technology supports the values of Everyday Lives.
January 14 1pm – 3:30pm	VTT/VOH	Navigating the Complexities of Meaningful and Functional Communication	All professionals in the field	In a communication-requisite world, we have a responsibility to ensure all people can communicate in a meaningful and functional way. It is not enough to rely on verbal language, nor is it sustainable to simply "know" what a person wants or needs. This training will explore the definition of communication through multidisciplinary perspectives, explain why it is important to accurately identify how an individual expressively and receptively communicates, and provide tools, resources, and strategies to support individuals with a variety of communication needs. An opportunity for discussion will take place at the end of the training.
