

- Co-sponsored ministry of the Felician Sisters and the Diocese of Pittsburgh
- Located in Western Pennsylvania founded in 1963
- Non-for-profit, non-denominational facility with unique programs for children and adults with profound physical and intellectual disabilities
- Provides both residential and day program services

Need for Remote Services

- McGuire Memorial closed the Employment Option Center and the Life Enrichment Adult Program on March 16, 2020
- Teams researched a variety of digital approaches for remote instruction
- Staff worked to think outside of the box to find ways to continue to provide activities













Person Centered Planning





- Continued normalcy/routine
- Flexibility
- Self Paced
- 1:1 Individualized and small group instruction





Ongoing Remote Services

 individuals were able to social distance
- McGuire Memorial will continue to offer remote services for the individuals who are not scheduled to attend the day program
- Some individuals are only comfortable or able to return at a modified schedule
